## **Assembly**

IMPORTANT! Always ensure that the cleaner is turned off before fitting or removing accessories.

#### **ASSEMBLY**



#### Step 1:

Insert the flexible hose (15) into the hose intake (1). It should snap into place.



#### Step 2:

Insert the narrow end of the flexible hose (11) into the extension tube (14). It should snap into place.



#### Step 3:

Press the tube release switch (12) and extend the length of the extension tube (14).



#### Step 4:

Connect the other end of the extension tube (14) to the 2-in-1 brush nozzle (16) (or other accessory (18)).

## Instructions For Use

#### Connecting to an electrical outlet:



- 1. Pull out the power cord (9).
- 2. Connect the power plug to a suitable electrical outlet.
- \* Do not extend the power cord further than the yellow mark on the cord.

#### Turning on/off:





- 1. To turn on, press the on/off button (6).
- 2. To turn off, press the on/off button (6) again.
- 3. After use, unplug the power plug and press the cable winder switch (10) to rewind the power cable (9).
- Guide the power cord with the other hand to unsure that the cord does not whip and cause damage.
- \* You can set the suction power of the vacuum by sliding the suction regulator (11).

The Floor Mode

For smooth, hard surfaces such as floors, stairs, wood, ceramic, tiles and marble.



The Carpet Mode

For soft surfaces such as carpets and rugs.

## Maintenance

IMPORTANT! Always ensure that the cleaner is turned off and then disconnect the plug from the power supply before performing any maintenance. During cleaning, do not immerse the electrical parts of the product in water or other liquids. Never hold the product under running water.

#### Emptying the dust container (2):

- Lift the dust container handle (5) and remove the dust container (2).
- 2. Hold the dust container (2) above a rubbish bin.
- 3. Press the release button to open the dust container (2) and empty it.
- 4. After emptying, close the lid.
- Place the dust container (2) back into its original position. It should snap into place.



#### Replacing HEPA filter (7):



- 1. Remove the air outlet grid by pushing the grid lock to the left.
- Remove the old HEPA filter (7) by pushing down the lock on the top of the filter.
- 3. Install a new HEPA filter and the air outlet grid in a reverse order.

It is recommended to replace the HEPA filter every 6 months or when it becomes visibly dirty for optimal performance.

### Cleaning the pre filter kit (4):

- 1. Pull up the lid release button (3) to open the top lid of the dust container (2).
- 2. Take out the pre filter kit (4) and the foam inlay. Rinse them under running water.
- 3. Clean the dust container (2) and the two cylinders with a damp cloth.
- 4. Allow the pre filter kit (4) and the foam inlay to dry completely before reinstalling into the dust container (2).

Replace the pre filter kit (4) if it can no longer be cleaned properly or if it is damaged.



#### General cleaning advice:

- 1. To clean, wipe with a soft, slightly moist cloth
- 2. Dry the product after cleaning.
- 3. Never use corrosive detergents, wire brushes, abrasive scourers, metal or sharp utensils to clean the product.
- 4. Store in a cool and dry place away from children and pets, ideally in original packaging.
- 5. Avoid any vibrations and shocks.

#### PROBLEMS AND SOLUTIONS

Low suction or poor pickup.	<ol> <li>Bin is full.</li> <li>Filters are blocked.</li> <li>The vacuum is set at the wrong height for the floor type.</li> <li>Blockage in the hose.</li> <li>Check the dust canister is fitted correctly to the vacuum cleaner, and the filter lid is closed securely.</li> </ol>	<ol> <li>Empty the bin. Refer to the empty the dust container' section in this manual.</li> <li>Check and clean the filters following the guidance in the 'How toremove and clean circular sponge filters and outlet HEPA filter'.</li> <li>Check which setting the suction regulator is on and adjust if necessary.</li> <li>Check the hose.</li> </ol>

#### WHAT Akitas WILL DO
