

## Before You Begin

Congratulations on the purchase of your new AkitasPro V15 Animal Cordless Stick Vacuum Cleaner. There are many useful features built into your stickvac. We recommend that you carefully read this instruction manual to take the best advantage of these features.

### Please read this manual before operating the cleaner

This will ensure you obtain full benefit from your new stickvac. Keep this Instruction Manual in a handy place for future reference.

### **Important**

Always switch off the appliance before cleaning, when not in use, attempting any maintenance task, fitting or removing accessories. This charger must only be connected to an AC power supply at the voltage shown on the rating label. This cleaner should be charged with the charger provided. This cleaner should only be used for its intended purpose as described in these instructions.

IMPORTANT! This product can not stand by itself, must be placed in the stand with the rod and motorised brush connected. Otherwise may damage the cleaner.

### **Precautionary measures:**



1. Do not operate the cleaner too close to heaters, radiators or other hot surfaces.



2. Before inserting the plug into the wall, make sure your hands are dry.



When you want to unplug the device from the wall, do not pull the power cable. Gently pull the plug from the power socket.



Before turning on the vacuum cleaner, safely remove any large objects from the floor or cleaning surface to prevent damage to the filter.



5. Do not use this vacuum cleaner to pick up water or liquids.

WARNING! To reduce the risk of fire, electric shock, or injury when using an electrical appliance, basic precautions should always be followed, including the following:

This cleaner should only be used for its intended purpose as described in this instruction manual.

#### Never operate the vacuum cleaner without filters.

Do not point the rod, power head, or any other accessory at the eyes or ears, nor put it in your mouth. Do not use on pets. Do not use this vacuum cleaner if the battery pack housing and/or the charger housing is damaged.

When using your vacuum cleaner, basic precautions should always be observed, including the following:

- This appliance is not intended for use by persons (including children) with reduced physical, sensory, or mental capabilities, or lack of experience and knowledge, unless they have been given supervision or instruction concerning use of the appliance by a person responsible for their safety.
- Children should be supervised to ensure that they do not play with the appliance.
- To prevent electrical shock, do not immerse the appliance, battery, or power plug into water or other liquids.
- 4. To prevent electrical shock, *do not* use the vacuum cleaner outdoors or on wet surfaces.
- The appliance and charger are intended for domestic indoors use only.
- Do not handle or operate the appliance with wet hands, and follow electrical safety precautions at all times.

- Extreme caution should be exercised when using the appliance on stairs.
- Do not attempt to change the accessories while the appliance is switched on. Use only manufacturer's recommended accessories.
- Do not use the appliance to pick up flammable items or combustible liquids (e.g., gasoline, hot ashes, cigarettes, matches, explosive materials, or anything burning), or use in areas where such substances may be present.
- 10. **Do not** use the appliance to pick up toxic materials (e.g., chlorine bleach, ammonia).
- 11. If the air inlet or floor head is blocked, switch off the cleaner immediately. Clear the blocked object before attempting to start the vacuum cleaner again.
- Before carrying out any maintenance service or cleaning the filters, always switch off the vacuum cleaner.
- 13. Keep openings away from your face and
- 14. Do not use the vacuum cleaner if it is



- damaged or broken. If connection cables are damaged, have them replaced immediately.
- 15. Never clean the vacuum cleaner or any of the electrical parts, especially the electrical connections, with water or liquid cleaners.
- 16. Never attempt to make any modifications electrically to the vacuum cleaner and
- 17. Always store the appliance battery and charger indoors in a cool and dry place.
- 18. Do not pick up water or liquids. For dry household use only.
- 19. Use the electric power head only for vacuuming dust and dry substances in the home.
- 20. Never touch the roller brush while the vacuum cleaner is switched on.
- 21. To prevent unnecessary wear on the power head, keep it moving while in operation.
- 22. Damage caused by improper use or by not observing the instructions in this manual will void the warranty.
- 23. Always check the power cable before use,

- the power cable and the power adapter should be in a good condition and must not be damaged. If the power cable or the charger adaptor is damaged or defective, it must be replaced.
- 24. Do not unplug the charger by pulling on the power cable. To unplug, grasp the power adapter, not the power cable and gently pull the power adapter from the power socket.
- 25. **Do not** operate the vacuum cleaner too close to heaters, radiators and other hot
- 26. Never operate or use the vacuum cleaner without the filters in place.
- 27. Before vacuuming, remove any large or sharp objects from the floor or cleaning surface in order to prevent damage to the
- 28. Never run over the power cable with the power head, as this may cause damage to the powercable.

### Battery use and care:

- The appliance is only to be used with the charger uniquely provided with the
- 2. Only charge the battery inside the product and only use the specifically designated charger to charge the product.
- When appliance is not in use, keep it away from other metal objects, like paper clips, coins, keys, nails, screws, or other small metal objects that can make a connection from one terminal to another. Shorting the appliance terminals together may cause burns or a fire.
- 4. Under abusive conditions, liquid may be ejected from the battery; avoid contact. If contact accidentally occurs, flush with water. If the liquid contacts eyes, additionally seek medical help. Liquid ejected from the battery may cause irritation or burns.
- 5. Do not charge or store the appliance outdoors or inside the car. Only charge or store the battery in a dry indoor are awhere the temperature is more than 0°C but

- less than 45°C. The charger is for indoor used only.
- Never attempt to open the battery for any reason. If the plastic housing of the battery casing breaks or cracks.immediately discontinue use and do not recharge.
- The charger adapter contains electrical connections inside. The charger adapter is not serviceable part.
- Before disposal of your battery, fully discharge your battery by running the product until it stops.
- The cleaner contains a Li-lon battery. Do not dispose the appliance with your local garbage. Contact your local council for instructions on how to safely dispose of the battery.
- 10. Do not use the charger to charge a non-chargeable battery.
- 11. Do not touch or insert objects into battery pack terminal.
- 12. Do not attempt to short circuit the battery terminal.

### **Before First Use:**


- 1. Carefully remove all packaging materials and retain for future use.
- Check for transport damage.
- 3. Before connecting the product to the power supply, check that the power supply voltage and current rating correspond
- with the power supply details shown on the product rating label.
- Risk of suffocation! Keep any packaging materials away from children-these materials are a potential source of danger, e.g., suffocation.



# **Assembly**

Important! Always switch off the cleaner and remove the plug from the electricity power supply before cleaning your appliance when attempting any maintenance task, Power off before any assembly or accessories replacement

Note: This product can not stand by itself, must be placed in the stand with the rod and motorised brush connected. Otherwise may damage the cleaner.



- Follow the illustration to insert one end of the rod into power head.
   You will hear a "click" sound when it is securely in place.
- Insert the other end of the rod into the air inlet of the cleaner. You will hear a "click" sound when it is securely in place.



Follow the illustration to insert the holder into the stand, then place the product in the stand.

### Instructions For Use

Akitas V15 offers multiple usage styles; it can function as both an upright vacuum cleaner and a handheld vacuum cleaner, adapting to different cleaning environments with its versatile forms.

### **Used as Stick Vacuum Cleaner:**




- Press the power button, move the product back and forth to start your cleaning.
- 2. Suction power button: Press it to adjust between Auto and Max modes.
- 3. After use, press the power button again to turn off the product.

#### Caution:

The power head rotates at a very high speed. To avoid damage to cleaning surface, do not stay in same spot for too long.

### **Display Indication:**



- A: Battery status indicator
- Remaining battery level is displayed as apercentage.
- B: Operation mode indicator
  - AUTO: Normal vacuuming
  - MAX: To vacuum with max suction power.
- C: Roller brush blockage indication
- D: Operation mode switch
  - The operating mode changes each time the button is pressed.
- E: Operation switch

To turn the vacuum on or off.

### Used as Handheld Vacuum Cleaner:




Replace the power head with attached 2-in-1 crevice tool, long crevice nozzle or mini motorised brush use it as a handheld vacuum cleaner.

### Charging the Machine:

Insert the charger cable into the battery charging port and the light flashes to start charging. (Both charging methods are available)



OR



### Charging indicator light:

Battery LED flashes indicates: battery require charging. When all three led stop flashing battery is fully charged. **ATTENTION!** As a safety precaution, the vacuum cannot be switched on while it is charging.

#### NOTE:

- 1. The battery does not come pre-charged. Charge the battery before use.
- 2. It is recommended to charge your product after each use to maintain maximum performance.
- For initial use, fully charge the product and use it 1-3 times until the battery is completely depleted to properly activate it.
- 4. Normal charging takes approx. 4-5 hours.

CAUTION! Do not try to open the battery or repair it yourself. The charging adapter contains electrical connections inside.

IMPORTANT! Disconnect the charger adapter from the mains power supply when the charger adaptor is not connected to the cleaner. Always use manufacturer's recommended charger.


Charge only within the range of 0°C to 45°C; extreme temperatures may extend charging time or damage the battery. If the temperature exceeds 50°C, overheating protection will activate.

### Maintenance

### Clean the Dustbin:




- 1. Switch off the cleaner and detach the rod and power head.
- Aim the dustbin at garbage bin, push down the release button, and gently sway the dust bin to empty the dust, then close back the dust bin bottom.

#### Clean the Filters:



 Press the button at the bottom of the dust bin and pull the dust bin outward to remove the dust from the main unit.



- 2. Take out the filters and clean them.
- After cleaning, reassemble the sponge filter, HEPA filter and filter mesh. Improper assembly of the sponge filter, HEPA filter or filter mesh could lead to air or dust leakage.


#### Attention:

The plastic filter mesh can be washed directly with water. Do not water wash the HEPA filter unless it gets very dirty. Before assembling back hepa filter, please make sure it is all dry (natural dry 24 hours).


Note: It is recommended to clean the filters after every 4-6 uses.

WARNING: Do NOT use the product without the sponge filter and HEPA filter.

### Clean the Power Head and Replace the Roller Brush:



- 1. Disconnect the power head from the rod.
- To release the brush roller from the power head.
   Press the 'push' button and twist the side cap clockwise. Gently pull the roller from the power head.




- If a build-up of debris is wound around the brush roller, remove by carefully cutting with scissors. Avoid damaging or cutting the bristles.
- To replace the brush roller, put the roller out from roller cover. Then mount the roller shaft matching floor clean task to roller cover bearing bush.
- To replace, carefully slide the brush roller back into place. Push the side cap down and twist it anti-clockwise simultaneously until it clicks into place.

### Clean the Mini Motorised Brush



- Rotate the left end cap clockwise while pressing the indicated arrow to remove the mini motorised brush roller.
- Clean any dust and cut off tangled hair or blockages by scissorsor knife.



- 3. Align the indicated arrow points on both ends and insert to assemble.
- 4. Rotate the end cap counterclockwise to secure and complete the roller reassembly.

#### Safety Precautions:

- 1. Keep hair, hands and feet away from rotating brush while the motorised brush is running.
- 2. Do not run the motorised brush over electric cables or string.
- 3. Do not use the motorised brush on pets.
- 4. If children are present, make sure to turn the vacuum off when leaving the motorised brush unit unattended.
- 5. Do not attempt to service or unclog the motorised brush while the vacuum is running.
- 6. The motorised brush will operate when it is connected to the vacuum cleaner.
